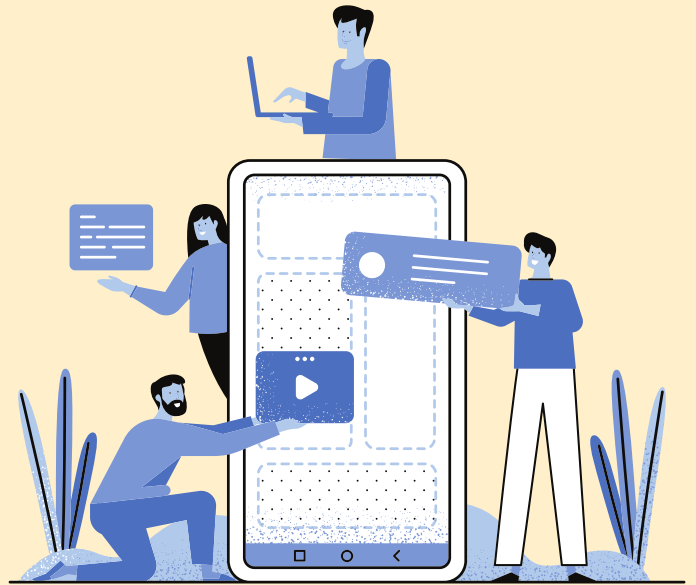
## SUMMER IS THE PERFECT TIME TO RESET AND RECHARGE

The theme for World Environment Day on 5 June 2023 focussed on solutions to plastic pollution under the campaign #BeatPlasticPollution.

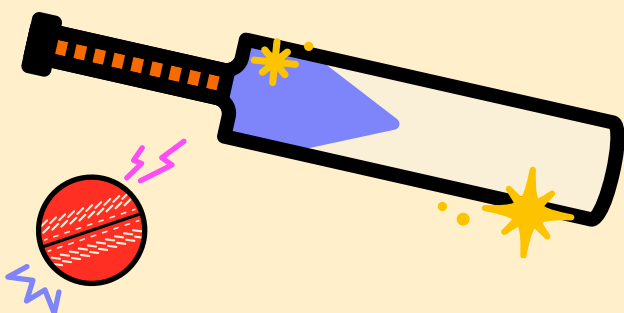


## TIMPANY SCHOOL CRICKET PREMIER LEAGUE

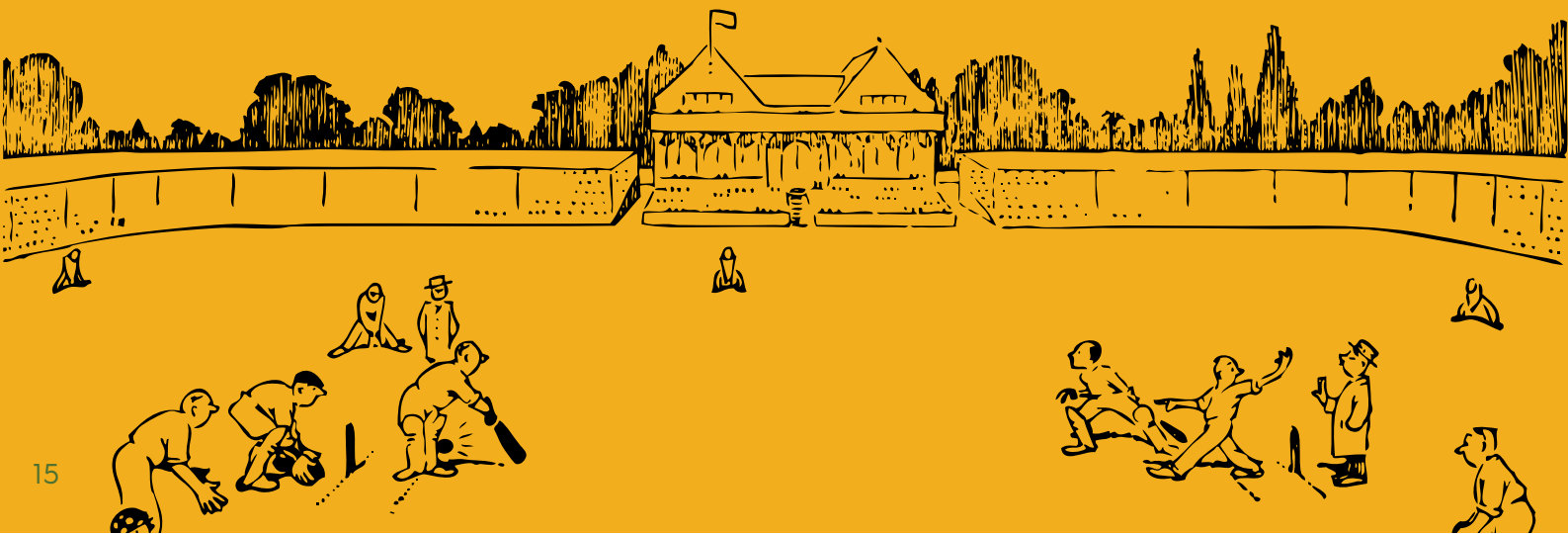

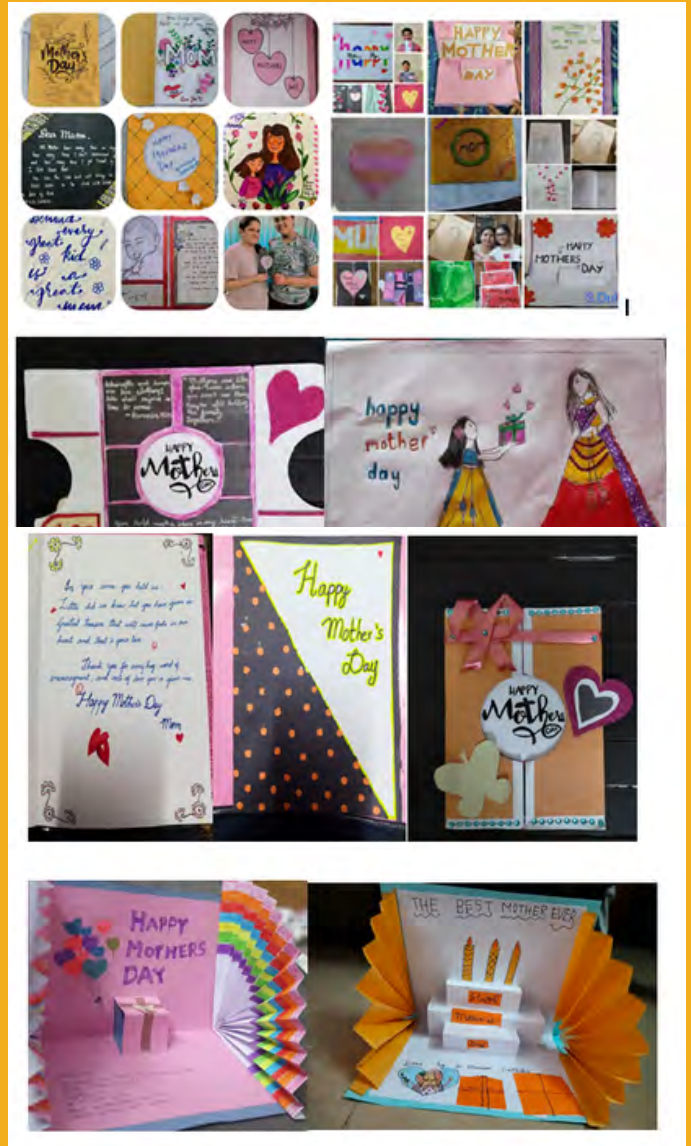

#### Class 4 - Bagless Day Activity - " WASTE ISN'T WASTE UNTIL WE WASTE IT "

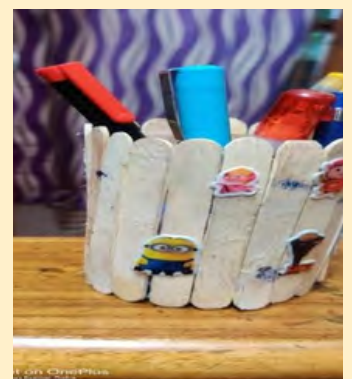

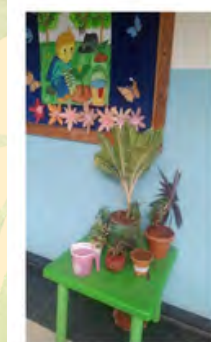

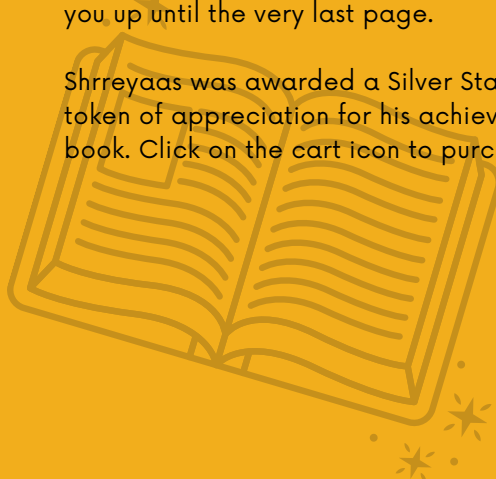


## The Mysterious Pentagram By The Silver Star Medallion Awardee - Shrreyaas K

"A father doesn't tell you that he loves you he shows you". The students celebrated the selfless love of their fathers on the 21st of June.

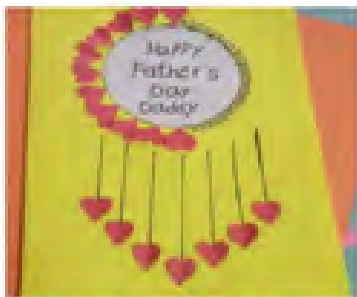

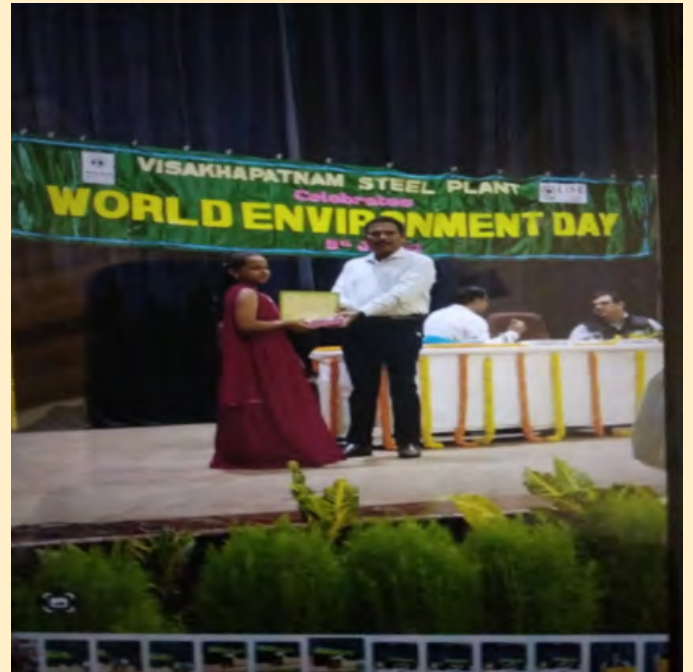
